

Jungfraujoch - Konkordiahütte - Fiesch

From the highest train station in Europe over the mightiest ice masses in the Alps

Program:

Day 1: We meet at 11:00 a.m. at the coffee bar in the Jungfraujoch station. Before we start the easy descent, the mountain guide will orient the participants about the behavior on the glacier. Downhill we go through impressive crevasse landscapes at a leisurely pace towards the Konkordiahütte, where we arrive later in the afternoon.

Day 2: So that we do not miss the sunrise, we will get up early. After a rich breakfast, we pack our backpacks and descend via the new metal staircase to the Aletsch Glacier, or better, to the Konkordiaplatz. Following the first medial moraine or Trugberg moraine, we will reach Märjelensee in about 3 hours. Those who wish can refresh themselves in the cold mountain lake or hike back to Fiescheralp. You will be back in Fiesch between 1:00 and 3:00 p.m. on the second day.

Price:

Not included mountain railway / cable car ticket and rental of crampons and climbing harness

Every **Thursday to Friday and Saturday to Sunday**, from June, 15th until September, 21rd, 2024.

Requirements:

Sufficient physical condition for a total walking time of **6 hours** is required. No mountaineering experience is required, but you should be sure-footed. A head for heights is an advantage (for the metal staircase from the glacier to the hut).



Equipment:

It is essential to keep the weight of the backpack to a minimum!

- Hiking gear (incl. long pants and jacket)
- Gloves and hat/headband
- Hiking or trekking shoes (no running shoes)
- Crampons
- Climbing harness
- Sunglasses Food and drink
- Inner sleeping bag (liner)
- Hiking sticks

In the Konkordiahütte there are no shower facilities and no running water!

Missing technical equipment (crampons and climbing harness) can be rented from us (CHF 40.00). We kindly ask you to reserve the rental material two days in advance.
